Therefore, it is our policy to only admit families to the practice who commit to the vaccine schedule recommended by the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP). This policy is not meant to be punitive or alienate others with differing views.

As medical professionals, we feel strongly that vaccinating your child on schedule with currently available vaccines is the right thing to protect our patients, their families and the community at large. Vaccines are most effective when given at the proper age, timing and sequence; as such, unless there is a medical contraindication, we do not support split or alternative vaccine schedules.
